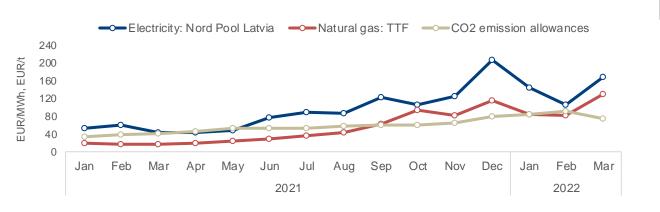
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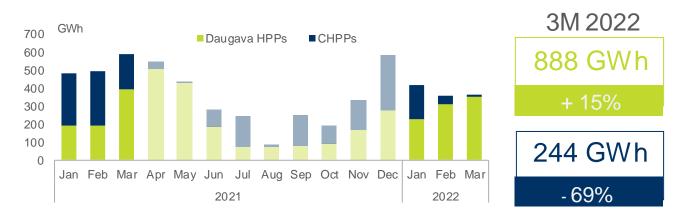
Record-high electricity and energy resource prices



Main facts - 3M 2022

- Electricity prices impacted by:
 - record-high energy resource prices
 - lower generation of hydropower plants in the Nordics
- The price of natural gas at TTF virtual trading point (front month) 5x higher, reaching 98 EUR/MWh (3M 2021: 18 EUR/ MWh)
- The average price of CO2 emission allowances (EUA DEC.22)
 2.5x higher, reaching 84 EUR/t (3M 2021: 37EUR/t)

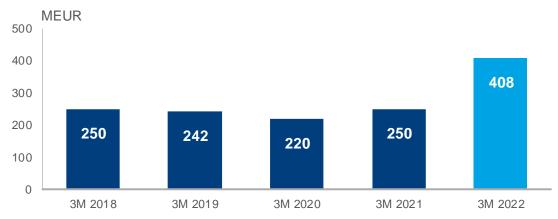
Generation at the Daugavas HPPs increased by 15%



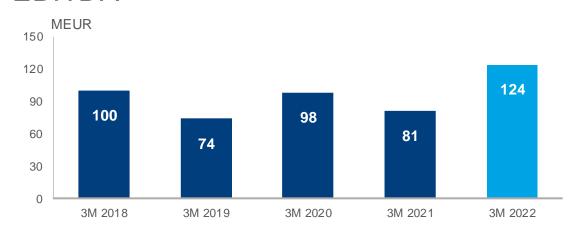

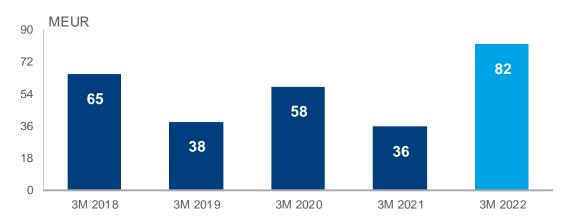
Revenue*



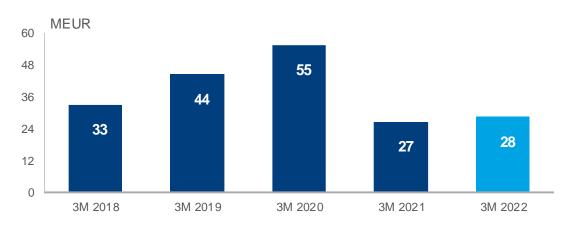
EBITDA*



Net profit



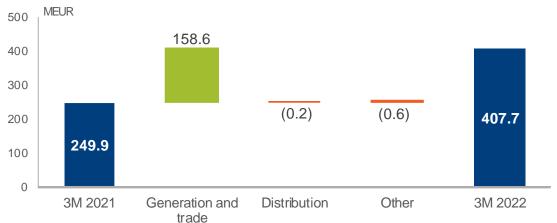

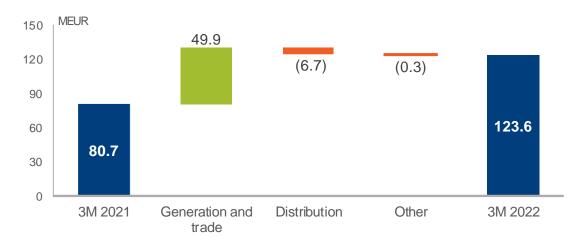


Latvenergo Group's EBITDA increased by 53%

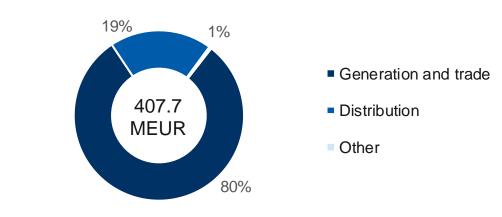
Revenue dynamics by segments



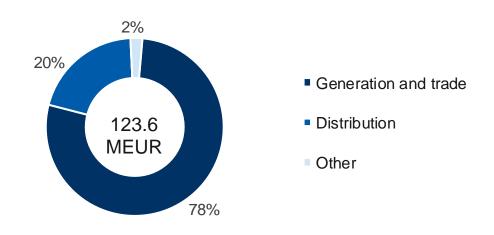
EBITDA dynamics by segments

EBITDA weight by segments

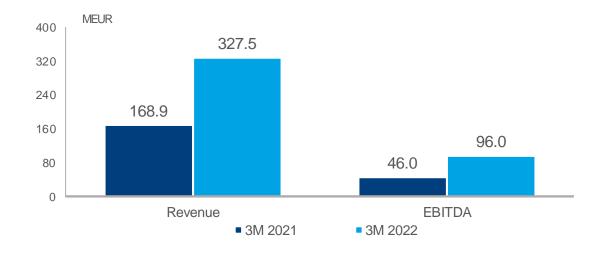

Revenue and EBITDA



Main facts – 3M 2022

- The segment's revenue positively mainly impacted by 141 MEUR higher energy sales revenues mainly due to higher electricity and natural gas market prices
- The segment's EBITDA positively impacted by:
 - the adjustment of electricity sales prices to the market situation
 - 15% greater output at the Daugava HPPs
- The segment's EBITDA negatively impacted by:
 - Record-high electricity and natural gas purchase prices as well as the price of CO2 emission allowances
- Latvenergo Group operates in all energy trade segments in Latvia, Lithuania and Estonia
- As of 1 January 2022, the average PSO fee is reduced by 57% – 7.55 EUR/MWh





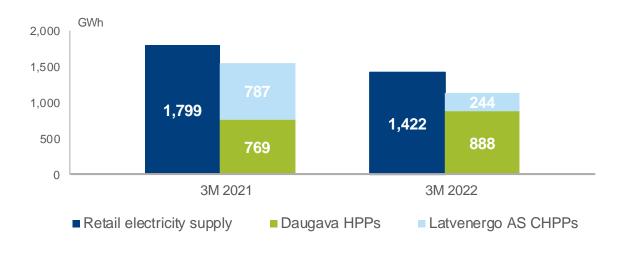






Latvenergo – largest green electricity producer in the Baltics

1,140 GWh of electricity generated



Main facts – 3M 2022

- Latvenergo produced 26% of the total electricity generated in the Baltics
- 78% of electricity generated from renewable sources
- Electricity generated at *Latvenergo* corresponds to 80 of the amount of electricity sold in retail
- Power generation at the Daugavas HPPs increased by 15%
- Power generation at the Latvenergo AS CHPPs decreased by 69% due to record-high prices of natural gas and CO2 emission allowances
- The amount of thermal energy generated decreased by
 15% due to warmer weather conditions, reaching 856 GWh



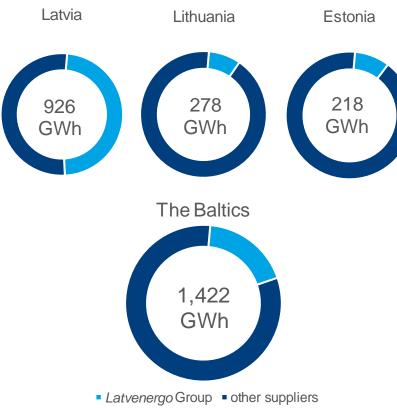

More than 1,600 contracts were concluded for the installation of solar panels

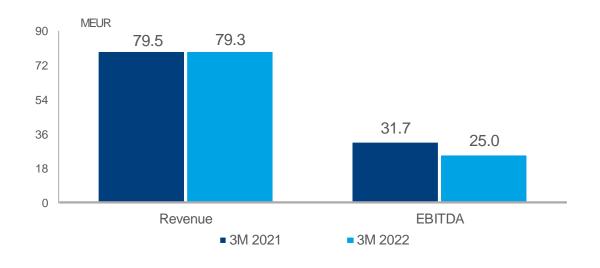

Revenue and EBITDA



Main facts – 3M 2022

- Electricity distributed decreased by 1%, reaching 1,695 GWh (3M 2021: 1,711 GWh)
- Financial performance was negatively impacted by higher electricity loss costs with the electricity market price in Latvia increasing 2.7 times
- Capital expenditure in distribution assets reached 18.6 MEUR (3M 2021: 19.5 MEUR)

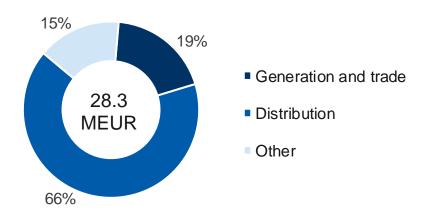






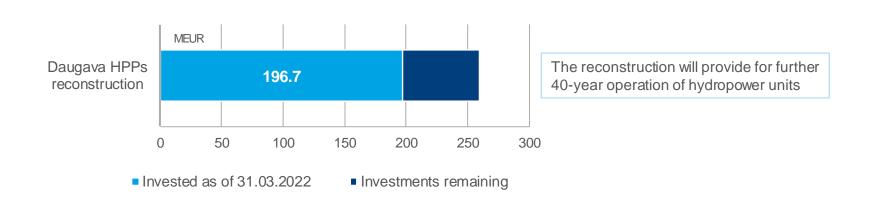

 Investments in network assets allows to improve the quality of the power network services and technical parameters

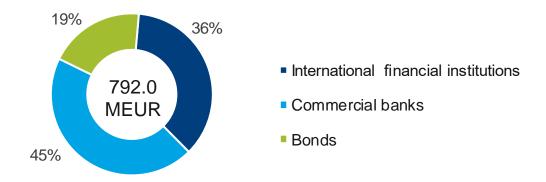

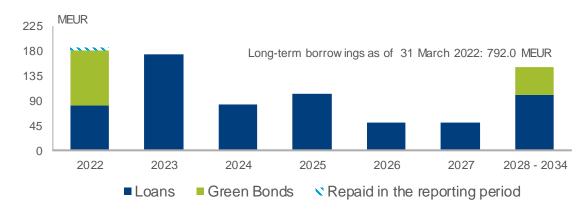

- In January 2022, Moody's published an updated Credit Opinion of Latvenergo AS.: Baa2 (stable)
- After reporting period, on 5 May, Latvenergo AS issued five-year green bonds in the total nominal value of EUR 100 million

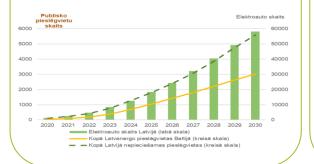
